Machine in Focus

Dump Truck characteristics: A very large heavy-duty machine used to transport loads over rough terrain. The vehicle usually has all-wheel drive or tracks and consists of a front section (tractor), and rear section (dump body). A rigid dump truck (tracked) is commonly called a tracked dumper.

Applications: Transporting construction materials around site and moving excavated materials to dumping locations on site.

Used in: Construction, Road Construction, Landscaping, Agriculture, Waste Management.

Aimed at: New and existing operators who want to gain work operating a dump truck and tracked dumper in the construction industry.

Course Content

Learners will receive guided training in the following areas:

- Understanding and complying with legislation, manufacturer's instructions and operator safety codes, relevant to the machine and work activities.
- People Plant Interface (PPI) awareness.
- General hazards associated with articulated and rigid dump trucks, and appropriate control measures.
- Identifying machine components / operator controls and completing pre-shift, operational checks and appropriate machine maintenance
- Preparing machines for site / road travel and working tasks.
- Driving and manoeuvring the machine over varying terrain and in confined or restricted spaces.
- Understanding the principles of Eco-Operation.
- Introduction to safety devices, including inclinometers, human detection systems and 360 cameras.
- Safe and correct operation of the dump truck when carrying out working tasks, including loading procedures and discharging loads into trenches or over edges.
- Understanding safe loading/unloading, on/off the transporter.
- Machine shut down procedures and security.

A blended delivery model will include theory, practical and simulator training.



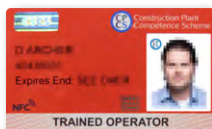
Operator Behaviours

Assessment
